WHEREAS:

- A. First Party is a higher educational institution named: Govindrao Wanjari College of Law Nagpur, Maharashtra, CD-2 Near Water Tank Hasanbag Chowk, New Nandanvan Colony, Nagpur, Maharashtra 440009
- B. SNG TAXSERV LLP, the Second Party is engaged in business of taxation advisory, compliance and litigation.
- C. First Party and Second Party believe that collaboration and co-operation between themselves will promote more effective use of each of their resources, and provide each of them with enhanced opportunities.

g) There is no financial commitment on the part of , Govindrao Wanjari College of Law Nagpur ,CD-2 Near Water Tank Hasanbag Chowk, New Nandanvan Colony, Nagpur, Maharashtra 440009 and the First Party to take up any program mentioned in the MOU. If there is any financial consideration, it will be dealt separately.

CLAUSE 3 INTELLECTUAL PROPERTIES:

 a) Nothing contained in this MoU shall by express grant implication, estoppel or otherwise, create in either Party any right, title, interest or license in or to the intellectual property (including but not limited to know-how, inventions, patents, copyrights and designs) of the other party.

CLAUSE 4 VALIDITY:

- a) This Agreement will be valid until it is expressly terminated by either Party on mutually agreed terms, during which period M/S SNG TAXSERV LLP, the Second Party, as the case may be, will take effective steps for implementation of this MOU. Any act on the part of M/S SNG TAXSERV LLP, the Second Party after termination of this agreement by way of communication, correspondence etc. shall not be construed as an extension of this MoU.

The place of the arbitration shall be at District Head Quarters of the First Party. This undertaking is to be construed in accordance with Indian Law with exclusive jurisdiction in the Courts of Nagpur.
