## ANTI RAGGING COMMITTEE Office Order

Ragging as per UGC Regulation Ragging constitutes one or more of any of the following acts: a. any conduct by any student or students whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness a fresher or any other student. Ragging is a cause for stress, anxiety, depression, and humiliations or tortures among students. It sometime also leads to the death of the victim. Therefore, ragging has become a painful trouble not only for students but also for colleges.

Prevention is better than cure. Ragging is conducted in college and therefore the college is first responsible authority to curb the menace of ragging.
